Job Summary

The role of a troop guide in NYLT is similar to that of the troop guide in a Scouts BSA troop. They are the key to facilitating the NYLT syllabus and advancing each patrol's development. Troop Guide may also be asked to fill the role of an Instructor in times of low enrollment of participants. This position must be flexible and willing to learn how to present different parts of the syllabus on the NYLT course.

Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend all Staff Development Trainings IN PERSON (including All Hands, Staff Developments, and other trainings as required by Council.)
- Attend the ENTIRE week of NYLT Course (Saturday to Saturday)
- Serves the assigned patrol as a mentor and Troop Guide.
- Assist in the training of the participants on course by helping to teach different parts of the syllabus.
- Works with the assigned Assistant Scoutmaster to ensure a quality NYLT program – they are your mentor, don't hesitate to work with them.
- Coaching and mentoring each day's patrol leader.
- Presenting selected sessions and activities of the NYLT Course
- Modeling the core learning and leadership messages of the NYLT syllabus.
- Being well-versed on all core content sessions and activities – KNOW THE SYLLABUS!
- Be familiar with camp emergency procedures.
- Help recruit youth participants.
- Report all issues with participants or staff to the NYLT Scoutmaster and MSR Ranch Director as necessary.
- Complete duties assigned by the ASPL Troop Guides, and the SPL.
- Assist in cleaning camp areas and buildings. This includes removing trash, cleaning restrooms and showers, and making sure the QM areas are ready for the next program.
- Other duties as assigned.

CERTIFICATIONS & REQUIRED TRAINING

- CPR, AED, and First Aid Training (Not provided by camp, Recommended)
- Youth Protection (Online Prior to Camp)
- Other training as required by Council and NYLT Management

REQUIRED FOR THE JOB

- Must be able to read, speak, and write the English language
- Must be able to work outdoors at an elevation of 7,000+ feet above sea level in varying weather conditions
- Must be able to pass a background check from the TRAILS database, CBI, and FBI
- Must complete all required State, Council, and National Trainings, and paperwork on time.
- Must be 14 years of age or older.
- Must be a current member of Scouting America.

If you need to miss a second Staff Development meeting, you need to have a conversation with your NYLT Scoutmaster, NYLT Senior Patrol Leader, the NYLT Course Director, and your Parent(s)/Guardian(s).

If you need to miss a third Staff Development meeting, you will need to have a conversation with the Council Coordinator and your Parent(s)/Guardian(s). This conversation will likely end in you being asked to not staff NYLT for the year, as we need staff to be able to commit to the entire process of NYLT, staff development through graduation on course.
