**Job Summary**

The YCL works closely with the Head Quartermaster to ensure that the facilities are prepared for the NYLT session. The purpose of the Youth Course Lead - Logistics is to foster a working relationship with the Quartermaster Team to ensure that the session is fostering a staff development process that will ensure that each Troop is prepared for running a week of NYLT.

**Job Description**

**ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Be a mentor to the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader – Logistics (ASPL)
- Attend all Staff Development Trainings – should be able to attend IN PERSON (including All Hands, Staff Developments, and other trainings as required by Council.)
- Model the core learning and leadership messages of the NYLT Syllabus.
- Work with the Quartermaster Team to ensure that they understand their role for each day of session, activity, food prep, and maintenance of the shelter.
- Help Recruit youth staff.
- Help Recruit youth participants.
- Be well-versed in all core content sessions, and activities equipment needs in order to act as a resource for the QM team.
- Be familiar with camp emergency procedures.
- Report all issues with participants or staff to the NYLT Course Director and MSR Ranch Director as necessary.
- Work with the QM team to make sure that program runs smoothly during camp.
- Assist in cleaning camp areas and buildings. This includes removing trash, cleaning restrooms and showers, and making sure all areas of camp are ready for the next program.
- Other duties as assigned.

**CERTIFICATIONS & REQUIRED TRAINING**

- CPR, AED, First Aid Certification (Not provided by the Council, not required but suggested)
- Youth Protection (Online Prior to Camp)
- Other training as required by Council and NYLT Management

**REQUIRED FOR THE JOB**

- Must be 18-20 – an adult participant in the BSA Programs
- Should have served in a Quartermaster role and have the recommendation of the Scoutmaster or Course Director of their previous course(s).
- Must be able to read, speak, and write the English language
- Must be able to work outdoors at an elevation of 7,000+ feet above sea level in varying weather conditions
- Must be able to pass a background check from the TRAILS database, CBI and the FBI
- Must be a member of the Boy Scouts of America

NYLT Policy on missing Staff Development (includes Staff Developments, All Hands, and other trainings required by council) Dates.

If you need to miss one Staff Development meeting, you need to have a conversation with your NYLT Scoutmaster, NYLT Senior Patrol Leader, and your Parent(s)/Guardian(s).

If you need to miss a second Staff Development meeting, you need to have a conversation with your NYLT Scoutmaster, NYLT Senior Patrol Leader, the NYLT Course Director, and your Parent(s)/Guardian(s).

If you need to miss a third Staff Development meeting, you will need to have a conversation with the Council Coordinator and your Parent(s)/Guardian(s). This conversation will likely end in you being asked to not staff NYLT for the year, as we need staff to be able to commit to the entire process of NYLT, staff development through graduation on course.
